
Except as otherwise provided in subsections 2 to 5, inclusive, it is unlawful for any person, either as owner, lessee
or employee, whether for hire or not, to operate, carry on, conduct or maintain any form of manufacture, selling or
distribution of any gaming device, cashless wagering system, mobile gaming system or interactive gaming system for use
or play in Nevada without first procuring and maintaining all required federal, state, county and municipal licenses.

















Securities Laws Some companies are arguing that sports betting, so long as bettors can buy and sell bets (like a wagering exchange) are governed solely by federal securities taws. The companies have been successful in getting initial TRO's issued, but no case on the merits has been decided yet
